Frequently Asked Questions

Do you make any age/grade exceptions?

- Unfortunately, we are unable to make any age/grade exceptions for any reason for all Studio classes.

Will you be holding auditions?

- Yes. Auditions will be held during the first two days of each Studio workshop. All registered students will be cast in a role. Students will be guided through the audition process as a part of the class.

My family has conflicts; can we still register?

- If your student is going to miss more than 3 rehearsals of a Studio Performance class, we do not recommend registering. It is a fast-paced process, and for your student to have the most optimal experience, it is best for them to attend every day of the class. We will be asking for conflicts during the first week of the class, and conflicts will influence casting decisions.

Will each student be “called” (attend) class each day?

- Yes. Studio Performance classes are first and foremost a class and therefore are designed to engage students each day of the session.

Is there a “pre-requisite” for Studio classes?

- There is not a pre-requisite; however, we do not recommend registering for Studio Performance classes if this is your young person’s first theatre class/camp experience. If this is your student’s first theatre experience (class or performance), we recommend a once-a-week actor training class instead.

When will performances be held?

- Performances will be held on the last day of the session, and more information will be shared with your student during the first week of class.
